

## Region M Meeting

May 25, 2005

Mexico continues to make minimal deliveries at Anzalduas Dam, therefore continuing to comply with the agreement reached in Washington DC. Mexico anticipates to increase deliveries at Anzalduas on May 27, 2005 assuring compliance with those understandings. We also continue to discuss with Mexico, the need for a more detailed delivery schedule to assure that payment of the remaining debt and compliance with this years deliveries is met.

Currently, Mexico has delivered at Anzalduas Dam approximately 80,000 ac/ft of a 150,000 ac/ft requirement. The remaining transfer to be made between June & September, 2005 is 146,000 ac/ft. As soon as Mexico agrees to the detailed schedule to meet the above requirements, this will be shared with all interested parties.
